- The test measures cognitive skills in the following areas: Reading, Mathematics, Science, and Language, as well as Verbal and Quantitative Skills.
- The HSPT testing fee is \$20. Please make checks payable to either Catholic Central or West Catholic High Schools. *Note: Families who qualify for the MI Free/Reduced Lunch program are not required to pay the testing fee.
